# **Egypt**

#### Cairo - Aswan - Luxor (5 Nights / 6 Days)

#### Day 1 – Arrival at Cairo

Arrival to Cairo international airport, meeting & assistance through passports and customs formalities by our representative. Transfer to your hotel (normal check in @ 14:00). Overnight at your hotel.

#### Day 2 – Three Pyramids, Papyrus, Perfume Shops & Egyptian Museum.

Breakfast at your hotel, start your tours by visiting the sole surviving Wonder of the Ancient World, Giza's Pyramids and the surrounding area. Arrive early if you want to get one of the limited tickets to visit their interiors. The Giza plateau is huge; Visit the 3 pyramids and the Sphinx from outside. After as much walking and exploring as you like. Lunch at Indian restaurant. Visit Egyptian Museum in Tahrir Square. Dinner & overnight on board of sleeping Train.

## Day 3 - Arrival To Aswan - Board the Nile Cruise

Breakfast on board of the train, on arrival to Aswan, you will be met by our representative. Start a visit the romantic and majestic Philae Temple on the Island of Agilika and High Dam. Transfer to your Nile Cruise for check in and enjoy the lunch on board. Overnight on board of the cruise.

#### Day 4 – KOM OMBO - EDFU

(Early morning optional tour to Abu Simble if you like) Breakfast buffet, sail to Kom Ombo, and visit the magnificent Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to the crocodile-god Sobek & Haerories. Followed by sailing to Edfu. Enjoy lunch and Dinner on board & overnight.

## Day 5 – EDFU - LUXOR

Today you have a chance to explore the Temple of Horus at Edfu and Visit Horus Temple. Then sail to Esna and follow sailing to Luxor at around sunset. Your Egyptologist will guide you around the Temple of Luxor and then onwards to the Temple of Karnak. Enjoy lunch and Dinner on board & overnight. (Optional at the evening) Sound light show in Karnak.
