Japan (Golden Route) 9 Nights/10 Days



<u>Day 1 – Arrival Tokyo</u>

Arrive in Tokyo - the capital of Japan. On arrival at Narita International Airport you will be assisted for transfer to the Hotel. Check In and Refresh. Day free to Relax. Or optional Visit at Sky tree, Shibuya Crossing and the Golden Gai.Later proceed to Team Lab Planet and Later free time for Shoping at Ginza Shopping Street. Overnight at hotel in Tokyo.

Day 2 -TOKYO CITY TOUR

After breakfasts, proceed for Tokyo City Tour Imperial Palace – Visit this place, the center of development of Edo-Tokyo, which was once the Edo Castle in the early modern period and has since become the Imperial Palace. Tsukiji, an area known as "Tokyo's Kitchen" for many years. Even after the market relocated, the Outer Market remains bustling with its many shops offering food and food-related items. Walk along the alleys throughout the Outer Market and enjoy shopping for goods and tasting local food. Senso-ji, Tokyo's oldest temple, offers plenty to see including the bright red Kaminarimon Gate, a statue of the god of thunder, and a five-story pagoda. The bustling street known as "Nakamise" stretches for about 250 m from Kaminarimon Gate to Senso-ji Temple and is filled with a plethora of shops. After watching a tea ceremony, experience preparing tea yourself and enjoy every sip. Head up to the Main Deck of Tokyo Tower, a symbol of Tokyo. Overnight at Tokyo.

Day 3 – Tokyo – Yuzawa Mountain

Today we have a full day excursion to Yuzawa Snow Mountain – a snow land surrounded by Japanese Alps. It is known for its deep powdered snow. Let's put on our snowshoes and enjoy gondola ride, snowmobile, sledging, sliding etc. All guests will have a short Meet & Greet session today during the bus journey.

Day 4 – MT. FUJI Tour with Hakone.

Today after breakfast we proceed to Mt. Fuji 5th station. This activity is weather permitting. We have some free time at Owakudani summit. Then we proceed to Hakone. In Hakone take a ride on the Hakone Ropeway. The journey from Owakudani Station to Togendai Station, which nestles on the shore of Lake Ashi, allows visitors to take in such spectacular views as the crystal-clear blue waters of Lake Ashi, the rising volcanic fumes of Owakudani and the grandeur of Mount Fuji on a fine, sunny day. Then proceed to take a cruise on the stunning Lake Ashi. Return to Tokyo. Overnight at Hakone.

Day 5 - Yunessun - Hakone

Today we visit Yamanashi Maglev Exhibition Center which offers informational exhibits on the future world's fastest bullet train. In the evening, we relax at Hakone Kowakien Yunessun – which offers traditional Japanese hot spring baths with gorgeous views of the Hakone mountains. Overnight at Hakone.

Day 6 -HIROSHIMA

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel. Today you will take a Bullet train experience from Tokyo to Hiroshima. On arrival in Hiroshima, visit Atomic Bomb Dome, Sadako Monument and the amazing structure of the Memorial Cenotaph, dedicated to the ordeal of the nuclear attack that the city suffered and the memories of its victims. Later, we visit the Hiroshima History Museum and Peace Park. After dinner check in to your hotel. Overnight at Hotel in Hiroshima.

Day 7 – Arrival Osaka

After Breakfast, Today we go to Miyajima island to see Itsukushima Shrine, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The shrine was established in the time of Empress Suiko and is famous for the

Floating Torii Gate. Then we visit Akashi-Kaikyo Bridge - One of the largest suspension bridges in the world which offers a spectacular panorama with a height of 300m and 360 °. Overnight in Osaka.

Day 8 – Osaka - Kyoto

After breakfast, visit the beautiful Arashiyama Sagano Bamboo Forest. Proceed to visit the Kyoto Botanical Garden – one of the oldest garden in Kyoto, which houses around 12,000 species of plants. Then we visit the beautiful Kinkaku-ji - one of Kyoto's leading temples. It is also known as The Temple of the Golden Pavilion & is recognized by UNESCO as a World Cultural Heritage. Then we visit the famous Todaiji Temple. After lunch we proceed to visit Nara Deer Park – A home to several freely roaming deer. Then we see the Osaka Castle from outside. Overnight in Osaka.

Day 9 - Osaka - Nara

After breakfasts, Today we head to Nara - the first capital of Japan. We visit Nara Deer Park – Home to hundreds of freely roaming deer. Nara's nearly 1200 deer have been designated as a natural treasure. Later we visit Todaiji Temple – A UNESCO World Heritage site and also one of Japan's most famous and historically significant temples and a landmark of Nara. Later we visit Kaiyukan Aquarium consists of over 15 large tanks, each recreating a specific region of the Pacific Rim, taking visitors on a virtual tour of the Pacific Ocean.

In the evening, we have free time for shopping at Namba/Dotonbori District.

Overnight at Osaka.

Day 10 – Depart for Mumbai

After breakfast, day free. Drop to Kansai International Airport to board the flight back to home India.
